Dear Parents and Carers

We have listened to feedback from our student council and parental surveys and we are delighted to inform you of further actions we have taken to support your child's learning. We have created an online year group TEAMS folders for Years 7 to 10.

In each year group TEAM folder, there are subject unit dashboards which detail exactly what your child must know, remember and be able to do in each subject. The dashboard also contains subject specific vocabulary to enable them to talk and write like an expert in the subject.

The dashboards are supported by the main lesson resources. Students will access TEAMS with their school email logins.

These will be essential for students in their preparation for end of year exams which will begin in May. We will send further information regarding this after the Easter holidays.

We have also published homework schedules on our website under 'curriculum' for parents and these are printed in student planners.

I would like to remind parents that all students have login details to the following learning platforms free of charge to support independent study and homework.

- www.classcharts.com – details merits, behaviour overview, timetables and corrections. All parents must have access to this.
- www.languagenut.com – Spanish and French grammar, phonics and vocabulary practice.
- www.readingplus.co.uk – English reading practice and fluency (all students should complete a minimum of 1 hour per week as homework in Years 7,8 and 9).
- www.mathswatch.co.uk - online lessons of Maths tuition, along with expert videos, quizzes and exam resources.
- www.kayscience.com - online lessons of Science tuition, along with expert videos, quizzes and exam resources.
